Abstract Guidelines and Submission Details

The TOGA Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) Local Organising Committee (LOC) welcomes abstracts on any scientific study of merit for submission, particularly those that provide new and original data relevant to the Australian and New Zealand environment. Abstracts pertaining to clinical trials, translational studies or quality of care focusing on thoracic malignancies will be highly regarded.

Abstract Guidelines

- Abstracts should represent the original work. Research work should be innovative. Work can have been presented prior to the TOGA ASM but **MUST** include new information to be eligible for an oral abstract or for the poster award. New information can be, but is not limited to, new sub-study analyses or secondary endpoint analyses not previously presented to a global or Australian and New Zealand audience. The exact criteria will be applied by the review committee during the review procedure. Any abstract not presenting new information can be presented as a poster.
- Abstracts on Pharmaceutical-company sponsored studies will only be accepted if they are investigator-initiated secondary or tertiary endpoint analyses undertaken without writing support. Additionally, the lead author and presenter must be an investigator from Australia or New Zealand.
- The submission of Clinical Trials in Progress as a poster presentation is allowed.
- Abstracts must fit at least one, and up to three, of the submission categories below.

- Biomarkers, genetics/bioinformatics
- Clinical trials in progress
- Epidemiology
- Diagnosis and screening
- Imaging
- Medical oncology interventions
- Thoracic cancer biology and novel targets
- Nursing and allied health
- Pathology
- Radiation oncology
- Surgery
- Palliative care/symptom management
- Risk factors and prevention including smoking cessation
- Health services research, care delivery, clinical trial access, and policy
- Improving the patient experience
- Survivorship

- Background
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words in length, excluding author(s) names, affiliations, organisations, and references.
 - Figures, tables, charts, and graphs are not permitted in the initial abstract submission, although they can be included in your poster.
 - There is no limit to the number of co-authors per abstract.
 - Individuals may only submit one abstract for oral presentation as first author, and one abstract as presenting author as a poster presentation. For clarity, if an author submits two abstracts, one abstract must be nominated as poster only.
 - Abstract titles should include capitalisation of the first letter of all major words in the title as well as prepositions, articles, and conjunctions of four letters or more. Do not capitalise all words.
 - Please only use standard abbreviations or define them in full.
 - Results must be included (excepting Trial in Progress submissions). Abstracts with “results will be presented” statements will not be considered.
 - Successful abstracts will be published in the ASM handbook and other ASM literature as applicable. Please ensure the complete first name, middle initials (optional), last name and institutional affiliations of authors is listed. Please note that submission of abstracts implies the author’s consent to publish the details.
 - The presenting author must be listed as an author on the abstract during submission. If for any reason the nominated presenting author cannot submit the final poster a replacement author can give the presentation, but the replacement presenter must have been listed as an author during the original abstract submission. If no named authors are available, the abstract must be withdrawn.
 - The submitting author must ensure that all co-authors have read and approved the title, summary, presenter names and affiliations. If the person submitting the abstract is not the corresponding author, please indicate who will receive correspondence about the submission.
 - Individuals should nominate whether they would like to present as an oral presentation with Q&A or poster. If there are too many oral presentation requests, some abstracts will be allocated a poster presentation regardless of request. It is proposed that each oral presentation is 10 min, with 3 min Q and A, however, the LOC reserves the right to change the duration of oral presentations due to merit or program scheduling.
 - Documents that do not conform to the guidelines will be asked to revise.
 - Documents received after the given deadline, due to any reason, will not be accepted unless the deadline is extended.

Abstract Submission

- Submit your abstract according to the above guidelines to info@thoraciconcology.org.au by **Monday, 6 May 2024**.
- After submission, you will receive an acknowledgement email of receipt.

About the Review Process

- Abstracts will be reviewed by the TOGA ASM LOC according to the following criteria:
 - Structure and clarity
 - Scientific validity
 - Originality and interest
 - Potential significance
 - Completed rather than future work (i.e. final results)
 - Specific rather than general findings
- Awards will be available for successful abstract presentations.
- The Best Poster Award is available to any applicant who presents a poster, except for those deemed by the review committee to lack novel content, or those presenting Trials in Progress.
- The Best Poster presentation will be awarded a prize subject to the following criteria:
 - Content
 - Organisation and layout
 - Design
 - Verbal presentation
- The TOGA ASM Convenor serves as the head of the Local Organising Committee and will make the final decision on which abstracts are accepted.
- Results of the abstract review will be sent to the author by **mid-June 2024**.
- If a revision is required, the revised abstract must be sent back within one week of request.
- If your abstract is accepted, you will be invited to register for the TOGA ASM. **NOTE:** Failure to register will result in withdrawal of the abstract.

New Investigator Award

- To be eligible for a TOGA ASM24 New Investigator Award, the applicant must:

- be a TOGA Member at the time of presentation. Industry members are ineligible.
- be the presenter and first author of the abstract.
- have primarily conducted the research presented in the abstract.
- be enrolled full or part-time in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree; OR, within 5 years of receipt of a relevant degree; OR, within 5 years of first presentation of research findings at a national or international meeting. Candidates who have career disruptions are still eligible provided they have been out of training for no more than 5 years full-time equivalent.
- provide a contact email address for academic supervisor / mentor at the time of abstract submission.
- The best oral presentation by a New Investigator will be awarded a prize subject to the following criteria:
 - Content
 - Organisation
 - Verbal presentation
 - Response to questions
- We reserve the right to withdraw the New Investigator Award if submissions are too few.

Presentations

- Accepted abstract authors will be invited to bring a Static Poster to be displayed in the meeting venue as well as submit the Poster in electronic format for the poster session.
- Selected abstract authors may also be invited to present an oral presentation as part of the main program.

Important Information for Authors

- If your abstract is accepted, the presenting author must register to attend the TOGA ASM by **15 July 2024**.
- If the co-authors would like to attend the meeting, their registration and payment are required to be made independently.
- Authors are responsible for proof reading and submitting an abstract or poster without errors, as they will be reproduced in the format they were submitted.
- The corresponding author is responsible for the abstract content. This author is the contact person for submission or communication purposes and is also responsible for disseminating information related to the co-authors.
